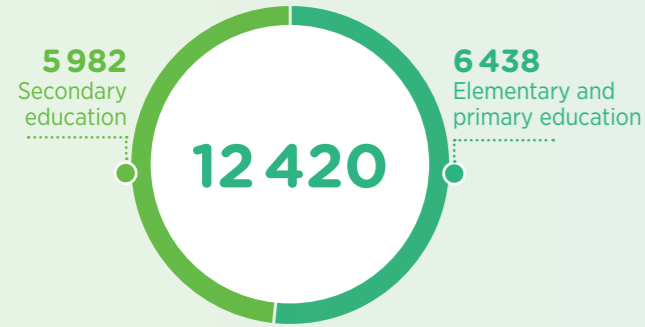
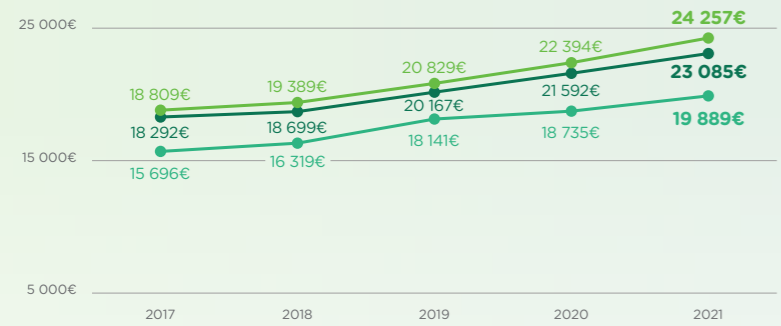

● Elementary and primary education ● Lower secondary education ● Upper secondary education

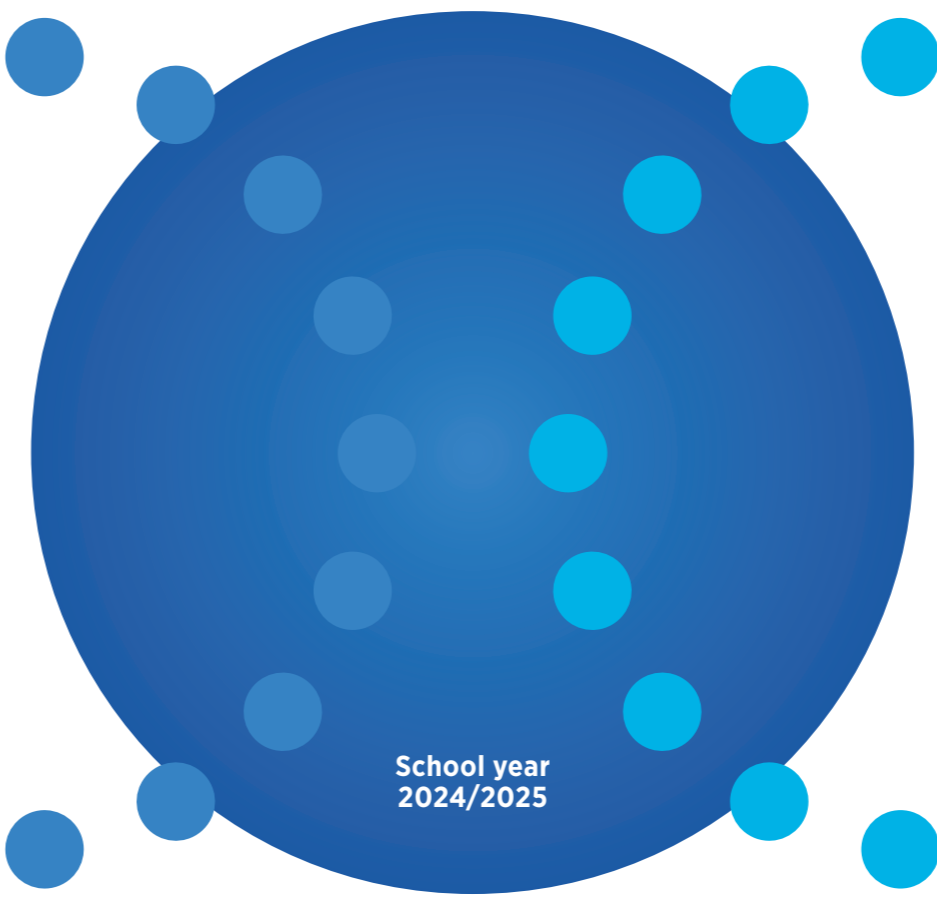

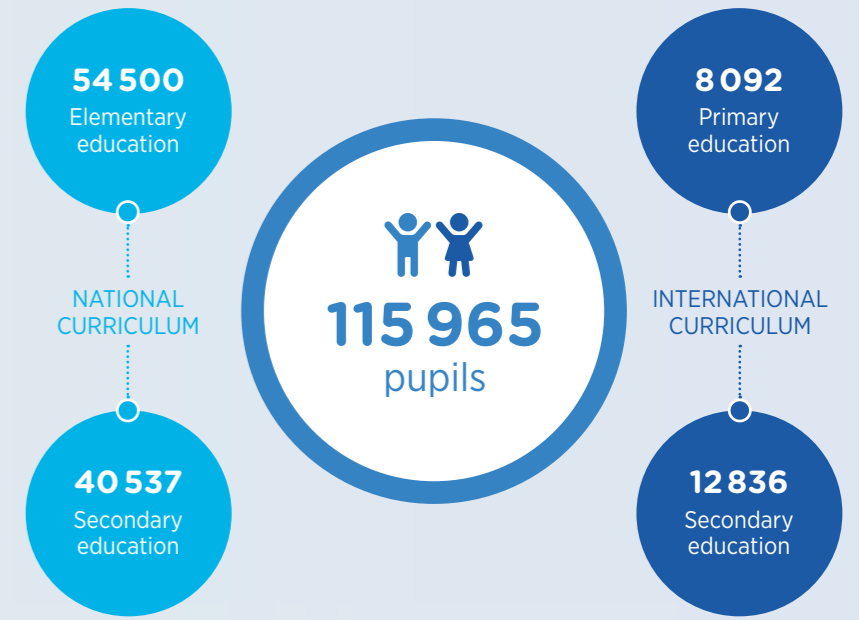

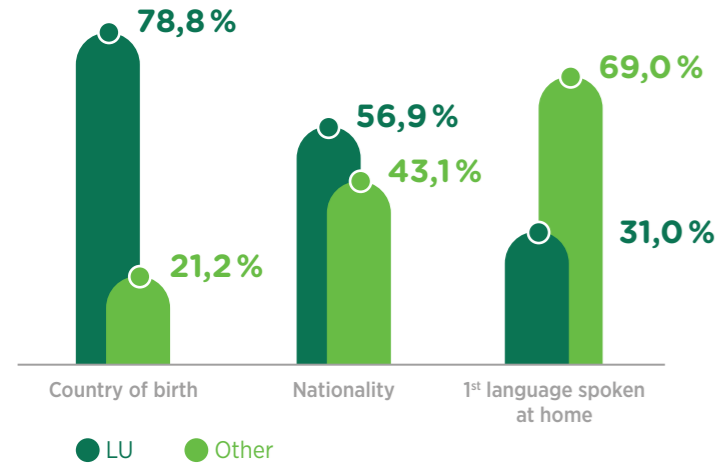

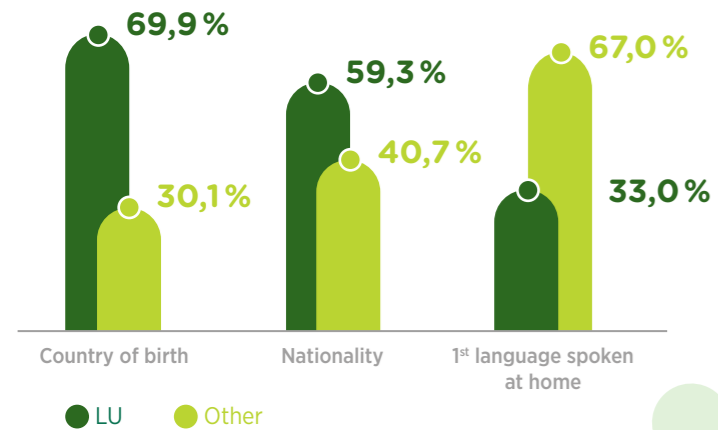

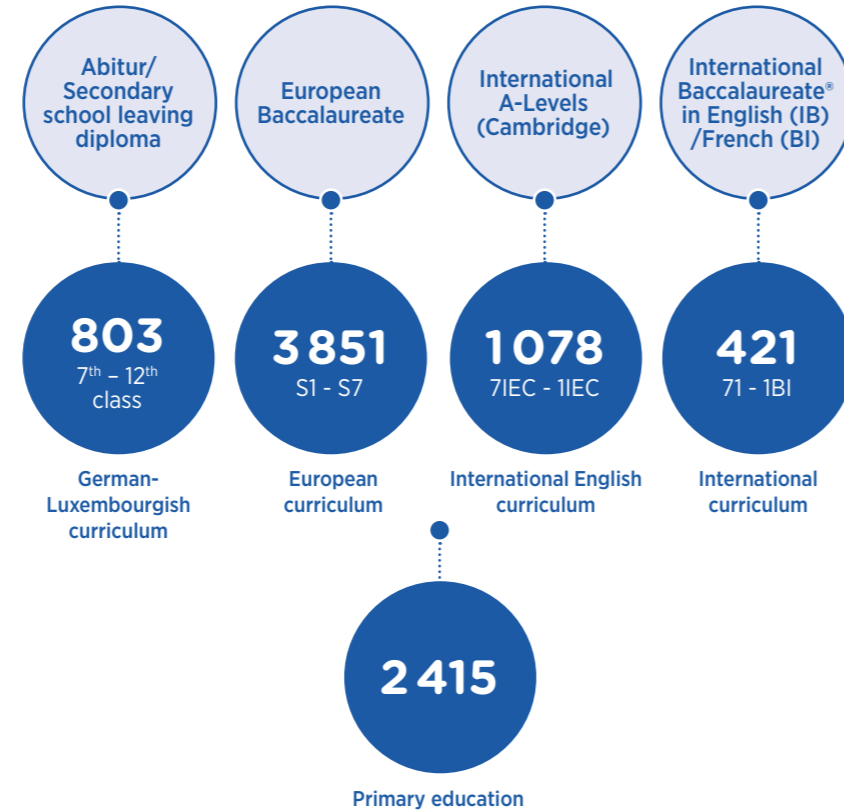

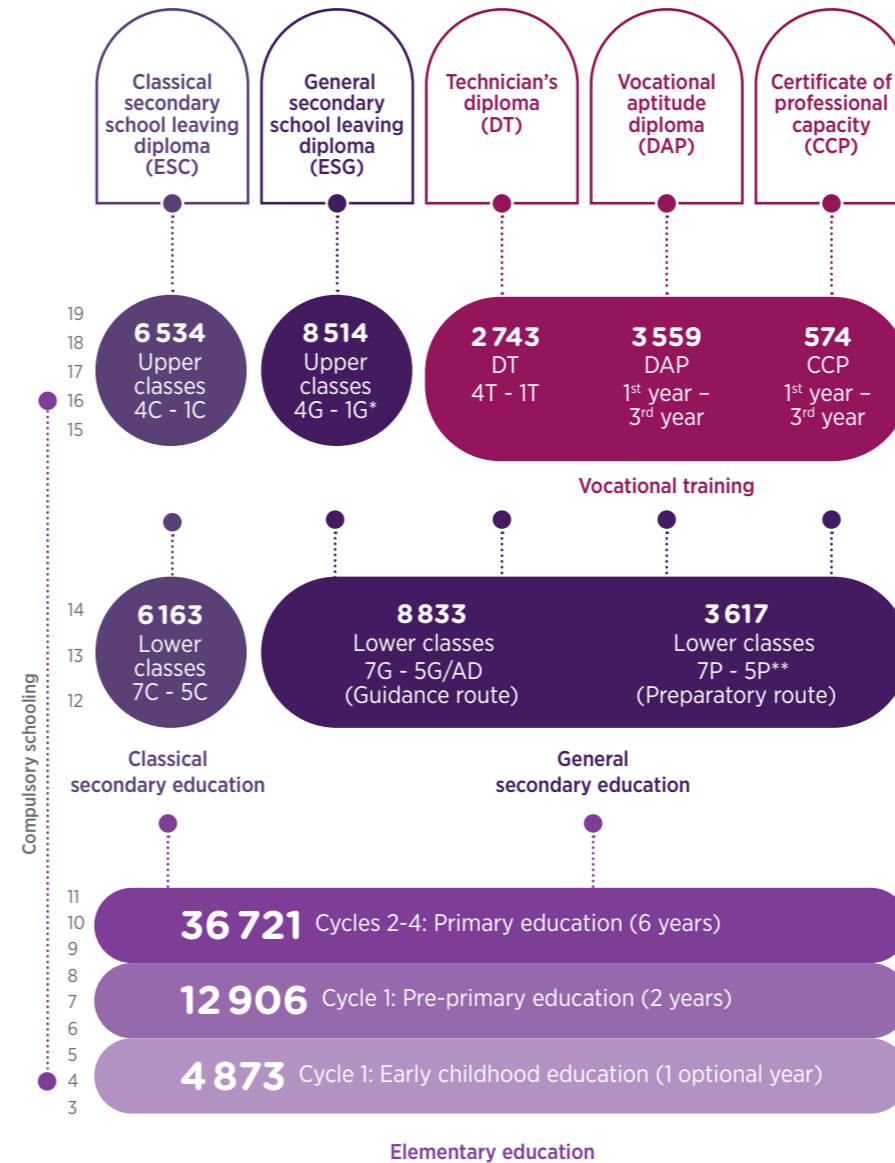

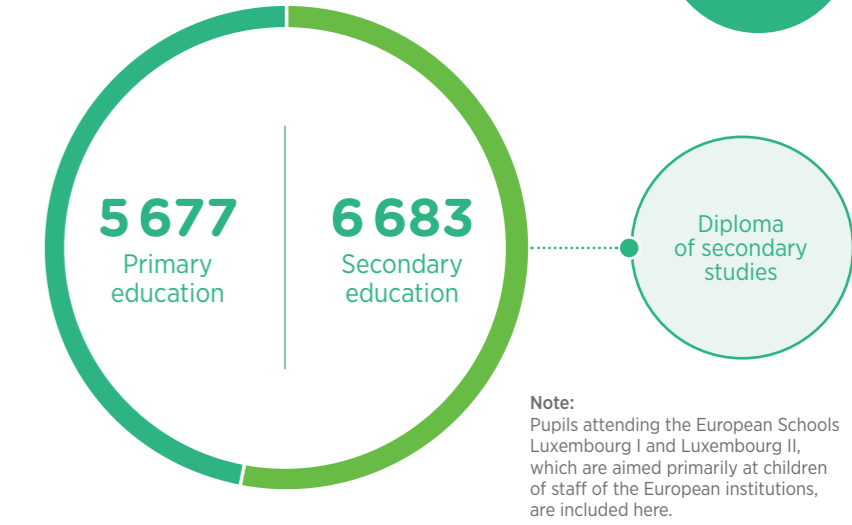
PUPILS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS – INTERNATIONAL CURRICULUM



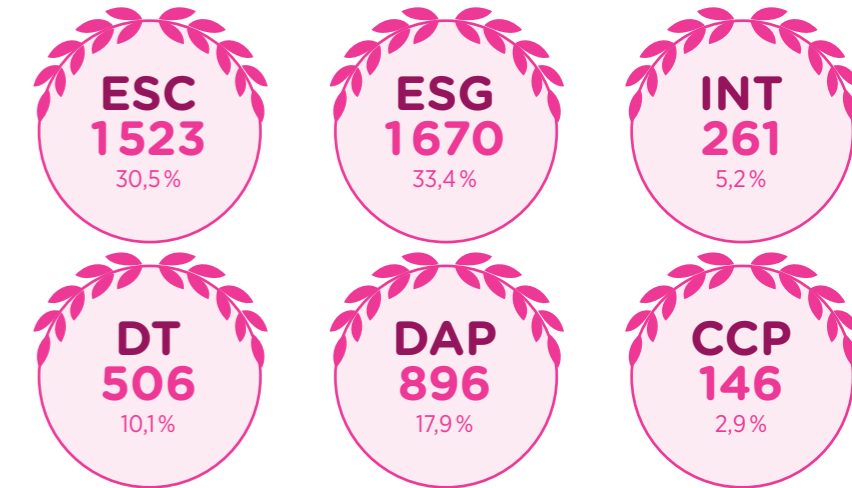
PUPILS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS – NATIONAL CURRICULUM
